

Cameron School District Fall 2023 COVID Guidelines

Face Coverings

Face coverings are optional for all students and staff throughout the school buildings.

Contact Tracing & Quarantines

COVID-19 is a Category 1 communicable illness per DHS, and according to DHS Chapter 145, we are required to report a known case of COVID-19 to public health immediately. Contact tracing will be completed at the direction of Public Health as necessary. The District will require quarantines of any students or staff that have been placed on quarantine by Public Health.

Per WI State Statute 252.21, students will be sent home if they are experiencing symptoms of a communicable disease. Students should remain at home until they have been symptom free for 24 hours.

Facility Cleaning

- All HVAC units will be set to maximize the amount of outside air brought into the buildings.
- District buses will be sanitized weekly.
- Hand sanitizer will continue to be readily available throughout the District.
- Routine daily cleanings will continue throughout all school buildings.
- Supplies will be available for staff to disinfect commonly used spaces, desks and equipment as necessary.

Food Service

Students will be reminded about good hygiene habits prior to entering the lunch line. Sanitation stations will also be located in the cafeteria area.

WIAA Athletics, School Activities & Field Trips

Guidance from the WIAA, WSMA, Heart of the North Athletic Conference will all be considered to safely hold events and activities. Spectators will be allowed with no restrictions. Field trips will also be allowed.

Parents & Families

Parents/families will be able to enter the buildings to drop off/pick up students in the designated locations within our buildings.

Parent Teacher Conferences throughout the school year will be offered both in-person and virtually.

Visitors

Visitors are to contact the office to determine if the visit is necessary and essential. Otherwise, visitors during the school day will not be allowed.
