APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS:

1. You must be:
 - a) a **current** high school senior in either the Rice Lake High School, Cameron High School, Birchwood High School or recognized Catholic Home School program,
or
 - b) a **current** high school senior from any other high school **and** a graduate of St. Joseph Catholic School in Rice Lake, WI.
 2. You must be a confirmed member of a Catholic parish.
 3. You must be a member of the current graduating class.
 4. You must provide your high school grade transcript.
 5. You must complete all sections of the scholarship application.
Please type or print legibly.
 6. Your name and signature can appear **ONLY** on the Cover Page.
 7. Please do not use or reference any family member's first or last name in the application.
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- Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded.
 - Scholarship applications will be available at your high school's student services office on April 1. **All applications are due back on or before May 1.**
 - Presentation of these scholarships will be at your school's senior awards program.
 - The first half of the scholarship money (\$500) will be sent to your college or university on or before August 15, 2016, provided you submit a copy of your first semester schedule to your high school office by that date (to confirm full-time enrollment).
 - The second half of the scholarship money (\$500) will be sent to your college or university on or before January 15, 2017, provided you submit a copy of your second semester schedule to your high school office as soon as it becomes available (to confirm full-time enrollment).
