A SCHOLARSHIP IN MEMORY OF JONATHAN (JON) TIMBLIN

To claim the \$250.00 scholarship award, a copy of the awardees' first semester grades and proof of second semester course enrollment must be submitted to the Cameron Student Services office prior to the start of second semester.
