Updates from our District Administrator

Spring School Board Election

District residents interested in filing papers for candidacy in the spring school board election should contact Brandon Olson, School Board President, or Joe Leschisin, District Administrator. Candidates for the board need to complete a campaign registration statement and a declaration of candidacy form available at the District office or on our web page www.cameron.k12. wi.us to ensure that the candidate's name is on the ballot in the spring election on April 7, 2026. The candidacy form must be completed, notarized, and given to the School Board President or Administrator by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 6, 2026. The candidate receiving the most votes in the spring election will be seated on the Board of Education for a three-year term. Bethany Stevens' term will expire in April 2026.

Open Enrollment

The regular open enrollment application period for the 2026-2027 school year begins on February 2, 2026, and ends at 4:00 p.m. on April 30, 2026. Parents must apply no earlier than February 2, 2026, and no later than 4:00 p.m. on April 30, 2026. The best way to apply is online. However, paper forms can be picked up in the District Office. For more information on open enrollment, please access the state website by going to https://dpi.wi.gov/open-enrollment.

School Closing Information

When it is necessary to delay the start of, or close or cancel school due to inclement weather, the District will use its automated communication system. A pre-recorded phone message will go out to the primary contact number for each family with students in the District. As such, please ensure that your child's primary contact phone number is up-to-date in the school office. In addition, an announcement will be made on local radio stations WJMC, WAQE, and WKFX. The district will also attempt to contact WEAU-TV and WQOW-TV, both out of Eau Claire. If time permits, a posting will also be placed on the District's Facebook page. Attempts will be made to make decisions the evening before a possible cancellation, but it is often difficult to make these decisions until early in the morning. Please be sure to discuss with your child(ren) what your alternate plan is in the event that school is closed early.

Our Epic Elementary School!

Elementary Walking Track

Starting Monday, November 3rd, the elementary school walking track will be open to adults who reside within the Cameron School District. This plan intends to provide time during the week for adults who live within the District to access the track throughout the winter months. This is an "adult-only" walking time and is not permitted for any students.

The track will be open Monday through Friday mornings, from 6:30 a.m. until 7:45 a.m., Wednesday evenings from 4:30 p.m. until 6:30 p.m., and Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday evenings from 5:00 - 7:00 p.m. through March 27th. However, the track will be closed the week of November 24th and from December 24th through January 2nd for the holidays. It will also be closed on the following days for scheduled elementary school activities: November 5, 6, 7; December 11 (p.m. session only), February 4, 5, 6, and March 6.

People interested in walking should be sure to enter the front doors of the school and should have a "nonstreet" pair of shoes to change into once inside. People will be able to sit in the cafeteria to change shoes. The cafeteria is directly to the left once entering the building. At that point, everyone should go directly up the stairs, take a left, and the track doors will be the first set of doors to the right. Gym bags and personal items will be able to be placed along the inside of the walking track on the east side of the gym.



Personal Electronics

If a student must have an electronic device at school, the device is to remain turned off and put away in the student's locker for the entire school day, unless the school principal has given prior authorization. Phone watches are allowed to be worn during school hours as long as all message and phone capabilities are turned off during school hours. Any violation of these guidelines will result in confiscation of the electronic device as described in the CMS Family Handbook. Students at CMS will have access to school-owned: desktop and laptop computers, ipads, cameras, and other electronic devices with the direction and supervision of staff and used for educational purposes only.


