Important Reminders for Families!

- * Students (K-4) should be in their classroom at 8:20 a.m. Student should not arrive prior to 8:00 a.m.
- * Doors to the elementary school will be locked during the day. Parents and other visitors should enter through the main doors and press the security buzzer. All visitors will be asked to sign in and wear a visitor badge. Parents or other visitors will not be allowed on the playground during recess.

Morning drop off

Please follow the morning drop-off procedures that have been developed for our new elementary site. If it is determined that revisions are needed, we will let you know. Safety of our students is our first priority.

- Use the entrance designated for the public parking lot/student drop-off/pick-up area.
- If you do not plan to come into school with your child, park your vehicle next to the sidewalk area designated for student drop-off or pick-up. Have children exit the vehicle on the side next to the sidewalk or plaza.
- If you plan to walk your child into the school, park in the parking lot and have your child walk with you to the sidewalk.
- Drop-off time is very busy and can be congested. Think safety and be alert! Please refrain from texting or talking on your cell phones. Thank you.

Dismissal

- Teachers escort all students to the lobby area at dismissal time. Students who ride buses are dismissed first.
- Doors to the elementary school will remain **locked** at dismissal time. All students will exit through the main entrance.
- If you are picking up a student, plan to arrive when buses depart at 3:09 p.m. Walkers will be released when all buses have pulled out of the bus loop
