

Credit Requirements at Cameron High School

Listed below are the graduation requirements for Cameron High School. Please note that they are listed as total credits required in each area. For some core areas you will start with the recommended level and follow in course sequence. In other areas you may select courses to meet each area of requirements at any time during your high school years. If a specific course is printed in italics, that class is needed for graduation. For example, *US History to 1865* must be taken in the 9th grade year followed by *US History from 1865* during the 10th grade year followed by *Global Studies* in 11th grade. Each course must be successfully completed before moving onto the next level of study.

Students will receive credit on a semester basis. Each successfully completed course will receive .5 credits per semester. Required subjects failed will result in the student having to repeat that course.

No student will be allowed to take a course a second time for credit with the exception of Band, Jazz Band, Concert Choir, Chamber Choir, Fabrics and Design, and Advanced Art.
