•Why Use Note Cards ?


- Avoid Plagiarism
- Organize information
- Easy to Reorder thoughts and ideas
- Fun to Shuffle

What is a source letter?

- Each time you use a new resource (book, website, etc.) any notes from that source get the same source letter.
- This helps you organize your cards according to topic, while still recognizing from which resource information came.

Plagiarism

- To plagiarize is to present as new and original an idea or product that was taken from another source.
- Source: Webster's Young Adult Dictionary



Avoiding Plagiarism

- Taking notes in your own words, in an organized way, will help you avoid plagiarism.
- Taking notes on note cards will keep the information organized and the words you use will be your own.

 Always use quotation marks on your note card when you write something exactly.





- Accuracy is important, especially with quotes and statistics
- Identify direct quotes with quotation marks around the phrases or sentences taken from the source word for word.
